You can work with your child on these pages going along with our class curriculum, or you can have them do a few each day after a couple of lessons and they have absorbed how to complete the tasks, or you can save them for the end of the chapter right before our test for a review. Whichever way you choose, students do not need to bring back these math pages for me to check. However, if you want to send back a specific page for me to check and go over with them, please send that in I will still be constantly reviewing and going over the concepts in class, even if students don't show me the workbook pages.
